#### **SCHOOL NEWS UPDATE with MR. GOMEZ:**

On, Friday March 13 Mr. Gomez will be meeting with a Latino parent group that has been organized by our Latino community liaisons, where these parents will have the chance to express some of their needs and things they would like to see changed.

2 things that have been expressed:

- Latino parents would like to participate more in PTA, SCC and other Parent groups/organizations
- Latino Parents would also like to help organize activities

Literacy Night- on March 18<sup>th</sup> we will host a literacy night, Mr. Gomez would also like to help educate Latino parents on ways they can improve on reading by using resources at home.

PPES has received approval to have the main playground redone- equipment is ok, but the grounds will be renovated.

An incentive plan is being put in place in the lunchroom to improve upon cleanliness and overall upkeep and behavior in the lunchroom.

We raised approx. \$38K for the American Heart Association, not a final number but we are close.

P30 is being effective and across grade levels we are seeing gains in all students. Many are moving on to Math. Teachers may use CMI math to assess depth of learning. CMI is in line with SAGE testing.

Dual Immersion in first grade enrollment has gone well and is full.

A Cinco de Mayo type celebration that was requested by teachers. Will be held on Friday May 8<sup>th</sup> and will be similar to Fiesta Night.

We have secured the Dance teacher/program full time next year.

A proposal is in process to make the Dance/Art program a part of the Specials curriculum

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## **GRANT UPDATE:**

Joanna Chesley:

Based on teacher surveys a wish list was developed.

\$7000 in grants were awarded. These include:

- A new paper trimmer is being purchased for the teacher work room
- Jr. Great Books material that was purchased by PCEF is being funding the 2<sup>nd</sup> round.
- More basketball hoops and mounts were purchased for PE
- Mr. Webb received some adjustable risers- he received money from PCEF, grant was also granted for costumes and props for performances  
A grant from Tanger is being pursued for portable risers
- Girls on the Run scholarships being set aside

Technology requests are on hold and being reviewed by the district

PCEF Site grants are issued and proposals are due at the end of the Month.
