### Performing Arts Elective:

All 6th grade students will be enrolled in a General Music course, where they will choose an area of specialization (Band, Orchestra or Choir). The students will all receive instruction concurrently in the core components of music (music theory, history and appreciation) and will demonstrate this knowledge by performing with their specific ensemble through the year.

### INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

August Registration: Registration information will be emailed home the first part of August.

Block Schedule: Full-time students have eight 80-minute classes per term. Four classes are on Blue (B) days, the other four classes are on White (W) days, alternating daily on school days. In addition, all students will have a 30-minute Advisory period each day.

Check-In: Any student who is tardy must report to the office. This helps us account for all students. If you would like your student's tardy to be excused, please send a note with your student. We do not accept phone calls for tardies. Any student without a note will receive an unexcused tardy for the morning.

Check-out: A note is required for any student who need to be picked up during the school day or before our final bell rings. Your student will bring their note to the office and we will give them a pass for 'Early Release.' A parent must enter the building to sign-out the student. We do not accept phone calls or emails for 'drive-by' pick-ups. Sending these notes for early release cut down on classroom disruptions and teachers greatly appreciate it.
